

As a former Head-of-State A340-300, this Executive A340 has a prestigious history and pedigree since it entered Executive Head of State service. This luxurious A340-300 was designed by, and the executive interior and upgrades installed by, Lufthansa Technik.

The interior design features a forward VIP stateroom with adjacent private lavatory and shower, second stateroom, multiple meeting salons with private seating areas and lounges. This Executive A340-300 can carry 145 executives and guests in the ultimate safety and comfort for 8,000 miles non-stop range. The spacious open mid and aft cabins can be further individualized and customized with the desired features by the next owner.

As a Head-of-State A340-300, the aircraft's care was meticulous, with full security, preventive maintenance and professional operation to the highest standards. This A340-300 is offered to be delivered where is as is on the "N" registry or can be delivered with fresh inspections and painted white or other delivery conditions as negotiated and agreed to by the buyer and seller.


Status

Interior Walkthrough

The next owner will enjoy and have private access in the most forward part of the expansive A340-300 VVIP cabin. Heads of State, Executives and guests can enter this wide body jet through a large forward entrance door. Once on board, the flight crew compartment is to the left, with a crew lavatory and large executive galley to store and prepare all the food, beverages, dining and catering requirements of the executive guests in flight or when using the aircraft on the ground as a private meeting location with full on board security.

This executive galley can be serviced and loaded through both a left and right aircraft door. A beautiful hall leads past a large and comfortable divan to the private office entrance. This divan can provide seating for security personnel.

The spacious private office can be used for meetings, resting or sleeping and is connected to the private VIP lavatory with shower. Inside the private forward lounge there is a large desk, on board storage and two oversized, comfortable divans and coffee tables. Both divans easily berth and converted into two beds. This quiet and closed off VIP lounge with private lavatory and large shower, sink, and storage provides an executive environment for meetings, sleeping, relaxing, or working. Passengers will enjoy the ultimate in this quiet, large and open space during their short or ultra long-range travel.

Aft of the forward VVIP quarters is a communication center that can provide secure sending and receiving of important calls or other communications. This space can also be converted to private storage for the VIP area.

A second expansive and fully equipped galley is located to further serve all the food and refreshment needs of the Head of State and VVIPs.

Aft of the second galley is a private conference room and lounge comfortably equipped with single chairs, double chairs and tables. This also converts quickly to offer a second, private stateroom with double chairs that recline to make two beds. Passengers can then select and enjoy a mid cabin lounge for reclining, dining or working in a large "U" shaped seating area in this space.

Aft of this private executive area, staffers and support personnel can enjoy a business class seating area with 24 oversized and comfortable seats, lavatories and galley services. Aft of the business class seating is additional seating for 92 guests joining the Head of State or VIPs traveling in the ultimate private, ultra long-range executive jet travel. The business-class seating and 92 seat areas can be customized to a VIP configuration.

From the mid cabin galley, the staff can go down the stairs to the lower galley area where storage and crew sleep can be accommodated. This Airbus A340-300 has forward and aft lower baggage storage area for up to several hundred bags, large private cargo areas, or high valued personal effects.




